Topics for submitted videos include (but are not limited to):

- Potential translation opportunities/practical applications for your fundamental research;
- A demonstration of technical research methods for a lay audience;
- · A unique/exciting/interesting approach to how research is being conducted;
- A new protocol that has been developed as part of your research.

The competition is open to all attendees of the Symposium, including students, Early and Mid Career Researchers, ACES Chief Investigators, and invited speakers.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- · Video is within 3 minute timeframe
- Video has not been produced for previous competitions
- Clear communication of technical information for broad audience
- · Demonstration of tips for making a good video, including:
 - Understanding of audience
 - Avoiding acronyms
 - Using accessible language for lay audience
 - Using landscape mode when filming with smart phone
 - Consideration of lighting
 - Clear audio
 - Use of range of media (e.g. photos, text, graphs)
 - Use of high resolution images, and legible graphs, diagrams and text
- Video focuses on aspect of electromaterials science research
